

Holiday Crime Prevention Tips



Burglary Prevention Tips:

- Report when a stranger knocks on your door to ask an unusual question or for an unknown person
- Lock your doors and windows and leave lights/radio on timers when not home
- Consider installing an alarm system
- Get to know your neighbors and report suspicious and/or strange vehicles and pedestrians
- Never give out personal information over the phone
- Keep front of the house visible, remove obstructions, also, consider keeping a family dog in the backyard

Auto Theft/Burglary Prevention Tips:

- Park vehicle in a well lit area
- Do not store any gifts or valuables in vehicles
- Consider installing an alarm system
- Keep vehicle doors locked and windows rolled up
- Never leave your vehicle unattended while "warming" it up
- Report any strangers in the neighborhood, especially late in the evening and night
