- Two cases involved thefts from vehicles
- Three cases involved a residence
- Two cases involved shoplifting
- A known suspect who had an active warrant was arrested in Atwater and turned over to LPD. He was interviewed and confessed to committing five recent burglaries
- LPD Officers went door to door and distributed crime prevention flyers to residences on Olds and Grapevine
