- Officers responded to a commercial burglary/shoplift case where the suspect had recently committed a similar crime. The 17 year old suspect was located and assaulted an officer at which time he was subdued by use of a Taser.
- Detective Radke and Officer Kang followed up on a burglary case which was connected to thefts of catalytic converters and obtained confessions from the “crew”. Charges are being sought through the Merced District Attorneys Office.
