### **Burglary Prevention Action Plan**

#### Education-

- Contact all residents to educate and encourage them to report suspicious people, vehicles, and activity in their neighborhoods
- Implement "adopt a school" program to allow officers to spend time at assigned schools to develop rapport with students and become role models educating them on crime prevention strategies

#### Prevention-

- Provide high visibility in areas with patterns of high criminal activity in patrol vehicles, police motorcycles, and mountain bikes
- Host crime prevention summits in neighborhoods and provide crime prevention tips and CPTED information
- Solicit Neighborhood Watch volunteers to organize patrols and assist in training of volunteers


## **Burglary Prevention Action Plan**

#### Proactive Enforcement-

- Contact all suspicious persons and vehicles in locations of high criminal activity and complete Field Interview cards
- Conduct probation and parole compliance checks and sweeps with zero tolerance for violations
- Coordinate other proactive enforcement strategies with other outside resources
- Utilize crime mapping and statistics to guide enforcement efforts

#### Proactive Investigations-

Utilize latest technology to conduct follow up investigations.
