Burglary Action Plan Status Report

2012/13 Statistics

January	25/4	May	11/0 (To Date)	September	2
February	14/0	June	11	October	4
March	18/3	July	6	November	3
April	14/7	August	3	December	9

(Includes vehicle, commercial, and residential burglaries)

- There was only one residential burglary in April which occurred 3 months prior from a previous tenant.
- Two were reported commercial, one beer run and the second was to the car wash storage shed.
- The remainder were car break-ins and the suspect(s) ID'ed.
- Officers continue to patrol areas that had previously been prone to high incidents of residential burglaries.
