
- Go Live June 7, 2012

- We have contacted over 1500 residents providing crime safety tips
- The LPD has arrested 10 subjects for burglary/attempted burglary
- 3 subjects were arrested for burglarizing Selma Herndon Elementary after detectives conducted follow-up and recovered property



## Joseph Gallo Dr. Parking Violations

- 57 parking citations issued over last 8 weeks (42 in May, 15 in June)
- Deploying A-frame signs additionally warning tractor-trailer drivers of parking restrictions
- Will continue to enforce and collaborate with TA on problem

#### **Animal Control Activities**



- Visited over 25 classrooms providing Animal Control Presentations
- Implemented animal trap deployment throughout the City to capture stray dogs
- City has purchased shelter to begin temporary in-house sheltering
