# Burglary Action Plan Status Report

## 2014/15 Statistics

January	5/4	May	1/7	September	2

(Includes vehicle, commercial, and residential burglaries)

- 2 cases involved thefts from vehicles at the B Street Temple
- 1 case involved an apartment
- 1 case involved a residence with a possible known suspect
- 1 case involved a vehicle burglary where the officers arrested the subject who confessed to numerous other burglaries. He was a former Livingston resident who now lives in Atwater. He also had shaved keys used for vehicle theft and items from other burglaries
- 2 cases involved commercial restaurant burglaries. Good evidence was gathered and the suspect has committed similar crimes throughout the San Joaquin Valley. The information/video was provided to media.
